**Jumping Skills and Sequences
Saturday, January 21st from 8 am – 12 pm**

This clinic is focused on improving how your dog successfully reads and reacts to jumps and is able to adjust to changes in path while driving a tight line. Improve your skills in handling 180s, 270s, serpentines and threadles – at all levels. Dogs should be over 12 months of age and sequencing with jumps.

**Improving Your Handling Skills
Saturday, January 21st from 1 pm to 5 pm**

The clinic is focused on improving your communication and handling skills for training and trialing with greener dogs. Understanding how our actions impact how our dogs will react on course, and building a strong foundation. Dogs should be competing at the Novice level or are getting ready to compete.

**Creating Drive and Speed
Sunday, January 22nd from 8 am – 12 pm**

This clinic teaches the handler how to create focus and enthusiasm in your dog to drive ahead. Enhancing communication between dog and handler that gives your dog the independence to maintain their momentum on course. Dogs should be competing at the Novice level or higher.

**Excellent/Elite Level Handling for Successful Teamwork
Sunday, January 22nd from 1 pm – 5 pm**

This clinic is focused on dogs already competing at the Excellent/Elite level and will work through techniques for figuring out how to handle difficult sequences at the highest competition levels. Dogs must be proficient on all obstacles. Clinic is suitable for handlers and dogs looking to fine tune their teamwork for even greater success.
